The Edith Borthwick School Home/School Agreement

1. Parents/Carers

I/We shall try to:

- See that my child goes to School regularly, on time and with the right equipment;
- Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour;
- Support school policies, especially on behaviour;
- Support my child at home with reading, homework activities and individual targets set at Annual review meetings;
- Attend Annual review meetings and parent/carer evenings to be a partner in my child's progress;
- Get to know about my child's life at school.

2. The School will:

- Contact parents/carers if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or behaviour;
- Let parents/carers know if there are any concerns or problems which affect their child's work or behaviour;
- Send home, as appropriate, reading, homework, activities or independence skills targets;
- Send home records of Annual review Meetings, Individual Education Plans and Annual Reports showing progress and achievement;
- Arrange Annual review and interim reviews, and two consultation evenings per year during which targets and progress will be discussed;
- Keep parents/carers informed about school activities through parentmail, letters, notices about special events and home/school diaries or student planners.
