We have carried out themed experiments, where the learners have explored different temperatures by

chipping away at ice and creating their own snowstorm in a jar! In our creativity sessions, we have made an array of crafts including elephants made from a collage of newspapers and giraffes made from cereal!

We have continued **developing our independence and life skills** through practicing handwashing, **teeth brushing**, washing our faces, and food preparation.
