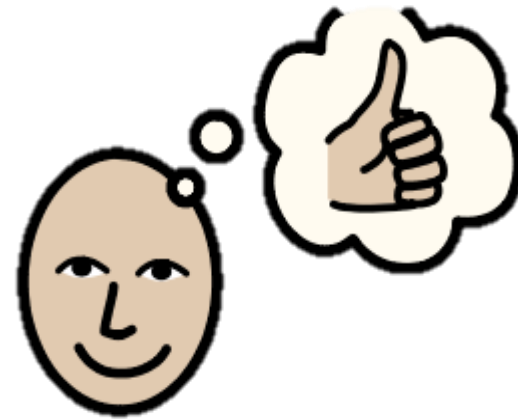


ACHIEVE

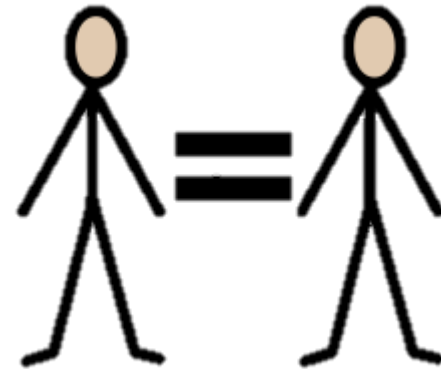


RESPECT

We are passionate about empowering our learners and school council offers an opportunity for our learners to have their say on a variety of matters.

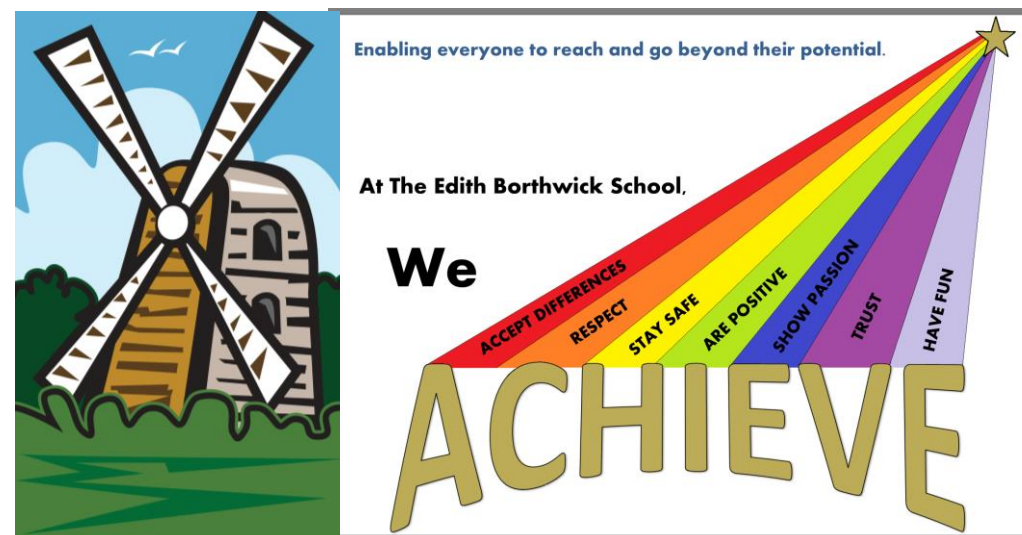
